Members were informed through MD Scope and other communications about necessary updates to website login credentials:

- You will need to reset and strengthen your password. A strength metre will help ensure your password meets the security standard.

If you haven't yet, we strongly recommend you update your login credentials as soon as possible to ensure you're all set for membership renewal, elections, your committees, etc.
